We will make every attempt possible to put you in the same space or close to the same spot as last year. Anything postmarked after January 10th will be charged an additional \$25.00 processing fee. Postmarked after Feb 14th will be charged an additional \$50.00 processing fee and postmarked after March 1st will be charged an additional \$60.00 processing fee.

Electrical power is available, but limited. Booth assignment, map, and further instructions will be mailed the last week in February. Confirmation of acceptance will be your <u>cancelled check</u>.

If you are a Non-Profit organization, you are allowed one booth at \$75; the second one is at full price. If you have a trailer that you serve from, please let us know what side so we can put you on the correct side of the street

Please provide enough of your own people for set up and break down. We DO NOT have personnel available to help you with loading/unloading your booth.
