Dear Potential Irish Day Vendor,

The Murphys Business Association and Murphys Firefighters Association are looking forward to hosting another Murphys Irish Day celebration and welcoming vendors on Saturday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

We will be limiting the number of vendors again this year. As in the past, preference will be given to our local member businesses as well as local artisans and food vendors when placing booths. We will attempt to accommodate booth location requests, particularly for our long-time vendors, however tweaks to our layout, may require us to adjust your location or you may be in the same location but it may have a new place number. We will again be sending confirmation emails when your application is received but will not cash the checks immediately or begin confirming acceptance until mid-late January.

As always, Irish Day is a rain or shine event, but we reserve the right to cancel the event if we are expecting extreme weather and exceptionally low snow, or there is a public health or safety issue. If the event is canceled by the organizers for any reason, your fees will be refunded.

Our booth fee structure remains the same as last year. Due to insurance requirements, we will need to receive your insurance certificates listing the County of Calaveras and the Murphys Business Association as certificate holders. All applicants, even long-time vendors, should provide a description of your booth and items for sale along with photos. Submitting everything by email is encouraged but snail mail is fine too. Please make sure your booth name is included with any correspondence so we can keep everything together.

Given our limited number of vendors, we will be evaluating all applications with an eye to prioritizing handmade, Celtic themed, interesting food, and artisanal items while making sure we have a good variety of everything. As a reminder, mass produced, and factory-made items are not allowed at this event. Murphys Irish Day branded items may not be offered for sale.

Please take note of our new vendor coordinator, Susan (you may have met her last year), and her phone number and email. She'll be your best bet for getting specific vendor questions answered.
