

MURPHYS IRISH day 2024

Cheat Sheet

Everything you need to know in a single place!

What time does the street close?

Main Street and the impacted side streets close at 6 am and will reopen at about 7 pm. Algiers, in front of the Community Park, will reopen around noon, and the theater parking lot will re-open at that time. Scott Street between Main & Jones will be closed during the parade.

What time does the event start and end?

The event starts at 10 am, and we start packing things up at 5 pm.

Where is parking for those with disabilities?

In the Masonic Hall Parking Lot on Church Street, but it fills up quickly. Additional parking is available behind Alchemy Restaurant. The Black Bart Theater Parking Lot across from the Community Park reopens after noon. There is additional public parking at 60 Jones Street.

Where will the shuttle drop me off? Is it and the parking at Ironstone free?

In the parking area behind Alchemy, near the back of Black Sheep Tasting Room at 221 Main Street...it is free! It runs from 9:30 am to 5:30 pm, but lines can form if it is a warm & beautiful day, so give yourself some time. We highly recommend parking at Ironstone.

Where do I buy my raffle tickets?

Sadly, we are not having a raffle for the trip to Ireland this year.

Where are the toilets?

We have many portable toilets and handwash stations located all along Main Street. There are also public restrooms in the Community Park.

Where will the parade be? What time does it start?

It will enter Main Street at South Algiers by the Murphys Historic Hotel at 11am and continue all the way to Big Trees Road intersection.

Where is the Pancake Breakfast?

At the First Congregational Church at 509 Algiers Street just a block off Main Street near the intersection with Church Street behind the Hovey Winery and Murphys Pourhouse.

Where do I get information or report a problem?

The Native Sons Hall at 389 Main Street.

Where is the Lost & Found?

At the Native Sons Hall at 389 Main Street.

Where is the First Aid Station?

At the Fire Department Booth at the corner of Main and Church Street near the Hovey Tasting Room at 350 Main Street.

Where do I take a lost child?

To the Fire Department Booth at the corner of Main and Church Streets near the Hovey Tasting Room at 350 Main Street.

Where are the beer and wine booths? Can I walk around with my drink?

There are three booths on the street, one at each end of the event area on Main Street and one near the Native Sons Hall. You may drink on the street within the event boundaries. Please do not take your drink into any business or outside the event area. No outside alcohol is allowed. Beer and wine sales end at 4 pm; there are no hard liquor sales on the street.

Will the Tasting Rooms be open?

Yes, most of our businesses, shops, tasting rooms, and restaurants will be open. Please enjoy their alcohol within the boundaries of the tasting room, pub, or restaurant. Some establishments close around 5 pm and re-open an hour or so later after the event closes.

Where are the stages, and is there a schedule?

The stages are located near the Murphys Historic Hotel at the corner of Main and Algiers, at the Moon Alley Patio at the corner of Main and Church, and by the Native Daughters at 268 Main Street. Schedules are posted [online](#), at each stage, and in the Native Sons Hall.

Where is the Community Park? Is that where the Murphys School of Music will be?

On South Algiers just about a block off Main Street. The Murphys School of Music will be playing from Noon-4 and the Park will be selling hot dogs, drinks, and other treats and hosting games, including a corn hole tournament.

Where is the Wine Information and Visitor Information Center?

At the corner of Big Trees and Main. Refill your water bottle there and get recommendations on wine, future events, and more. Make sure to ask them about Spring Wine Weekend.

Where is the Scavenger Hunt?

At the Native Daughters Hall at 268 Main Street.

What else is going on this weekend that we should know about?

Unfortunately, we don't have reliable ride-share services available here, but you can try Murphys Taxi at 209.795.7777. Please plan accordingly, arrange a ride, have a designated driver, walk to the event, space out those drinks, enjoy some non-alcoholic drinks and fun food between tastings, and stop drinking early...we want you to get home safely!
