Returning and New 2026 Irish Day Vendors,

The Murphys Business Association and Murphys Firefighters Association look forward to hosting you on Saturday, March 21st, 2026, during our Annual Murphys Irish Day celebration.

Our vendor spaces are limited, so priority will be given to our local member businesses, returning vendors, and local artisans when assigning booths. Please include your location request in your application, including last year's space number (if available) or the name of the business you want to be located near. We will try to honor your request wherever possible. We will send "confirmation of receipt" emails upon receipt of your application, but we may not begin verifying acceptance until mid-January. Please note that application processing fees increase as the event date gets closer.

As always, Irish Day is a rain-or-shine event. We reserve the right to cancel the event if we expect extreme weather, exceptionally low snow, or a public health or safety issue. If the organizers cancel the event for any reason, your full fees will be refunded.

Our booth fee structure remains the same. Please be prepared to provide proof of insurance & resale permits, upon request. Other required licenses or permits (environmental health department, etc) must be submitted with your application. This year, mobile food vendors must obtain Environmental Health Permits in advance and provide copies to us by March 2nd, 2025. Temporary Food Facility Applications may be included with your vendor application.

Those selling food or providing services such as massage, face painting, or similar "hands-on" offerings must include insurance certificates listing the County of Calaveras, Murphys Business Association, & Murphys Firefighters Association as additional insureds with their application.

Applicants must provide a description of their booth and offerings, along with a link to their website and social media pages, or booth photos if they have no online presence. Email submissions are encouraged. Please include both your name and your booth name so we can keep everything together. We will not assign a booth until your application is complete, including all required documentation (fees, licenses, insurance forms, Food Facility Permits, etc).

As a reminder, mass-produced and factory-made items are not allowed. Murphys Irish Day branded items and alcohol may not be offered for sale. Celtic themed, artisanal items, and food are prioritized
